#### PURPOSE:

To explain how to access your child's state test scores from the PowerSchool Parent Portal.

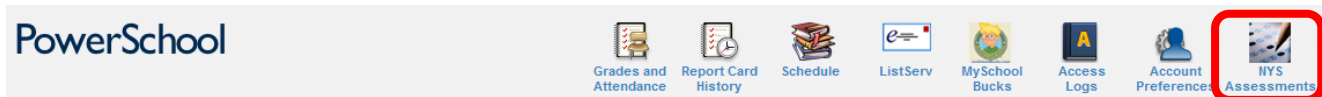
#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Log on to the Internet and go to: <http://ps.levittownschoools.com> to login to your Parent Portal Account.

If you use another Browser (Chrome, Firefox) see **\*Browser Note** on Page 3.

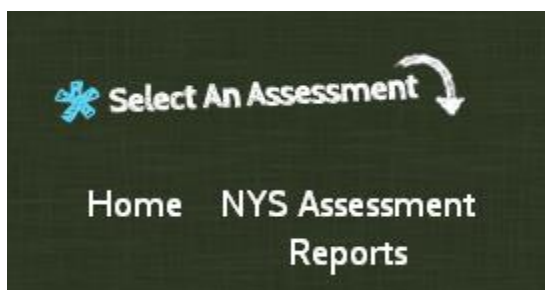
2. For accounts that contain more than one student, click the name of the student Betty Justin from the student list.

3. Click the **NYS Assessments** icon  on the Navigation Bar:



4. The icon brings you to your child's State Assessment Portfolio Home (Welcome) Page.

5. Click the **NYS Assessment Reports** link in the center of the page.

The results of these tests, together with the conversations you have with your child's teachers, help you to understand how well your child is performing, and to identify any areas in which your child may need extra help. 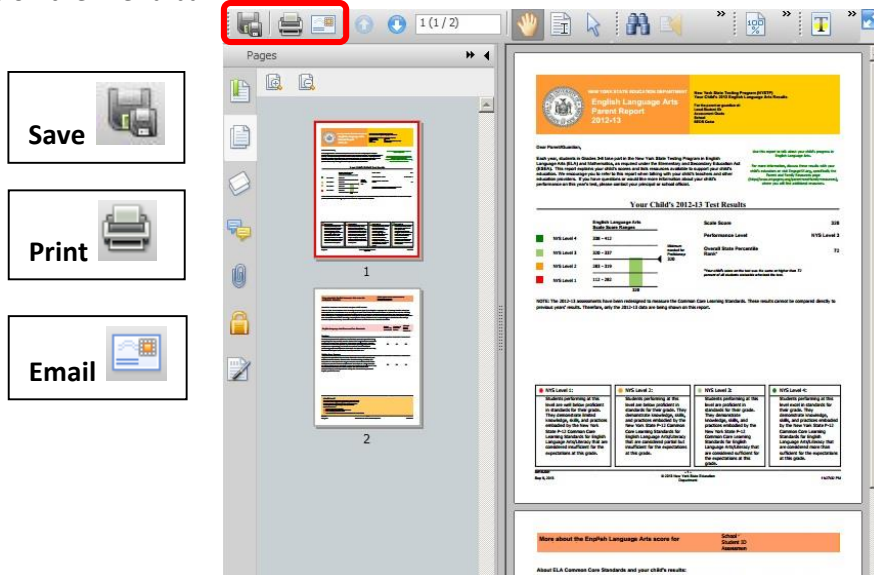

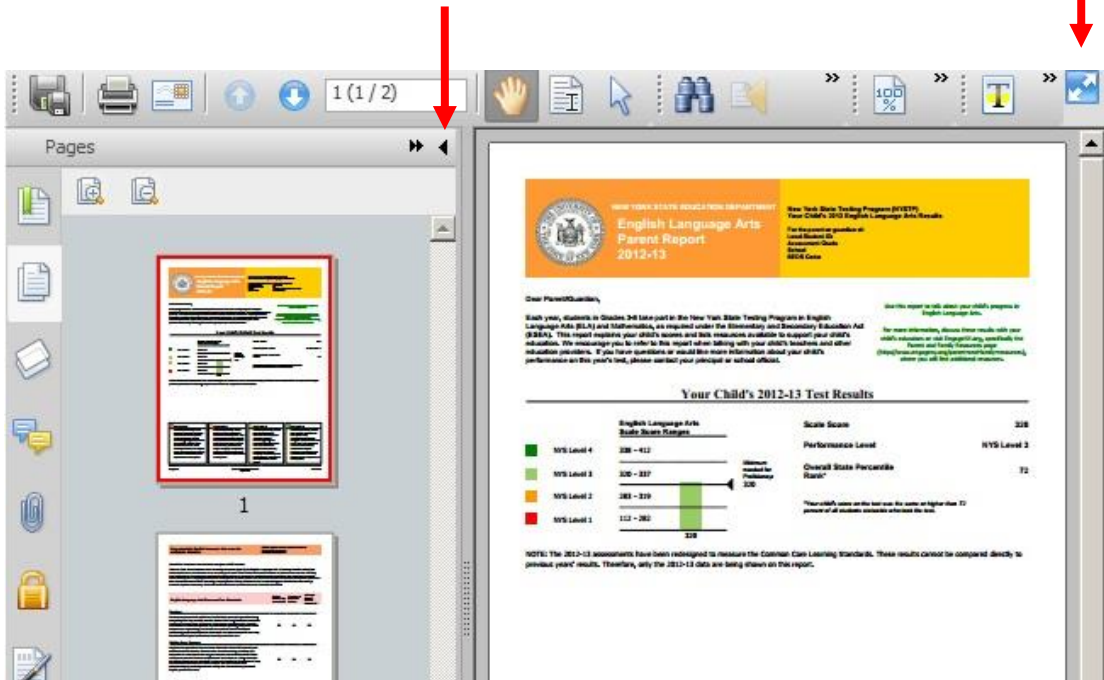
7. Click an assessment listed for the desired year:

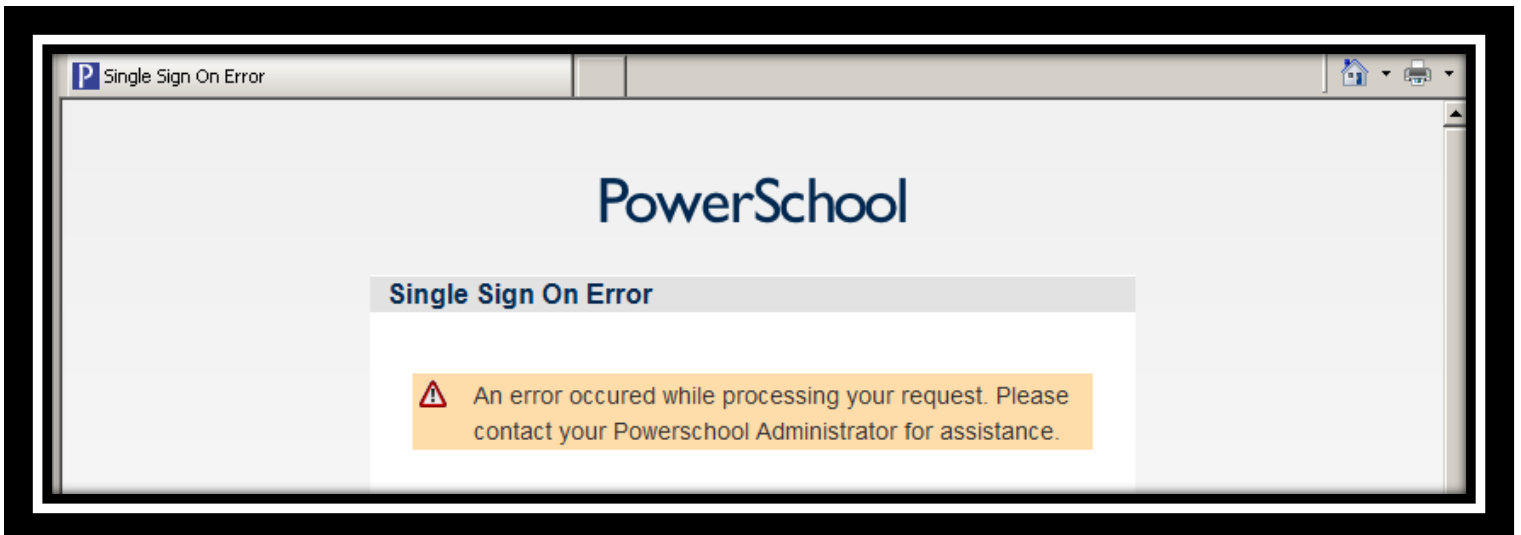
